An Act to amend The Legal Profession Act.

(Assented to , 1931)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Legal Profession Act Amendment Act, 1931.*"

2. *The Legal Profession Act*, being chapter 206 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 20 thereof by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following

"20. The voting papers shall be opened by the secretary in the presence of the auditor of the said society, at the hour of eleven o'clock in the forenoon of the day of election, and the secretary shall then scrutinize and count the votes in the presence of the said auditor and keep a record thereof."

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 31 thereof by adding at the end thereof the following new paragraph.

"(g) The creation of a special fund by setting aside any portion of the moneys of the society or by paying into such fund periodically out of the revenues of the society any portion thereof, or by both of such methods, as the benchers may determine, and the application of the revenue from such fund to the relief of aged, infirm or disabled members of the society and the dependants of deceased members, and for the administration of such fund and the relief to be given therefrom.

"Provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall render it obligatory upon the benchers to create such fund, or, having created the same, to continue in whole or in part the fund created; but the benchers may at any time in their discretion discontinue such fund in whole or in part, and upon such discontinuance, transfer the amount thereof or any part thereof with any revenue therefrom then undisposed of to the general funds of the society."

4. The said Act is further amended as to section 34 thereof by striking out the words "twenty-one years" where the same occur in paragraph (a) of the said section, and by substituting therefor the words "twenty-three years"

5. The said Act is further amended as to section 35 thereof—

- (a) by adding after the words "British subject" where the same occur therein, the words "of the full age of twenty-three years";
- (b) by striking out the words "for a term of one year in continuous periods of not less than four months each" where the same occur in paragraph (b) of the said section, and by substituting therefor the words "for a continuous period of one year"

6. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
