An Act to amend The Urban Mining Operations Act

(Assented to _____, 1931.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Urban Mining Operations Act Amendment Act, 1931*."

2. *The Urban Mining Operations Act*, being chapter 25 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1930, is hereby amended by inserting therein, immediately after section 3 thereof, the following new section

"3a. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other statute, and notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any transfer, deed, agreement, contract or any other instrument, no minerals of any kind, sort or description underlying or subjacent to any land which is the site of any highway, street, lane or public place within the corporate limits of any city, or town, which has a population of more than five thousand according to the last census taken by the Government of Canada, shall be mined, worked, disturbed or removed in any way whatsoever unless and until the use of the overlying surface as a highway, street, lane or public place is permanently discontinued."
