

## BILL

No 64 of 1931.

An Act to amend The Legislative Assembly Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1931.)

**HIS MAJESTY**, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Legislative Assembly Act Amendment Act, 1931*."

**2** *The Legislative Assembly Act*, being chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 58 thereof by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:

"58. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint a barrister of at least ten years' standing as Legislative Counsel, and may fix his remuneration and prescribe his duties."

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
