An Act to amend The Alberta Police Act

(Assented to 1931)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows

1 This Act may be cited as "*The Alberta Police Act Amendment Act, 1931.*"

2. *The Alberta Police Act*, being chapter 82 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1923, is hereby amended by adding as section 19a, immediately after section 19, the following:

"**19a.** The Attorney General, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, may at any time and from time to time enter into an agreement with the council of any municipality for the policing thereof, by the Alberta Provincial Police, for such period and upon such terms as may be agreed upon by the Attorney General and the council, and the council of every municipality shall have power to enter into the said agreement and upon any such agreement being entered into the municipality shall be excused from maintaining a police force under the provisions of the previous section."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to
