An Act respecting the Payment of certain Arrears of Taxes
by the Soldier Settlement Board

(Assented to _____, 1931.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows

1. In the case of lands vested in the Soldier Settlement Board pursuant to *The Soldier Settlement Act*, being chapter 188 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, 1927, if the said board pays, at any time before the first day of February, 1931, any taxes of any kind collectable by a municipal district and payable by the conditional owner of any such land for the year 1930 or any year anterior thereto, no penalties shall be added to such taxes after the fifteenth day of December, 1930, and the amount of the taxes with penalties added up to the last mentioned date, if paid as in this section provided, shall be deemed to be in full satisfaction of all such taxes and all penalties thereon.

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
