An Act to amend The Brand Act

(Assented to _____, 1931)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Brand Act Amendment Act, 1931*."

2. *The Brand Act*, being chapter 66 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 2 thereof by inserting therein, immediately after paragraph (h), the following new paragraph:

"(hh) 'Sheep' shall mean any ram, ewe, wether or lamb."

3. The said Act is further amended by inserting therein, immediately after section 3, the following new section:

"3a. Every brand for sheep shall consist of either a burnt brand, an ear-mark brand or a fleece brand, and no person who is not registered for a fleece brand shall be registered for any other brand, and no person who is registered for a fleece brand shall be registered for more than one other brand."
