# BILL

No. 12 of 1932.

An Act to amend The Dairymen's Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1932.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Dairymen's Act Amendment Act, 1932.*"

**2.** *The Dairymen's Act*, being chapter 162 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 21 thereof by striking out the words "Every association may borrow money for the purpose of its business and" where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "The association may borrow money for the purpose of its business and may draw, make, accept, endorse, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bills of lading, warrants and other negotiable or transferable instruments and may."
