HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Public Health Act Amendment Act, 1932."
- **2.** The Public Health Act, being chapter 58 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 22b thereof by striking out the words "and state that one-half of the expense is to be borne by the municipalities" where the same occur therein and by substituting therefor the words "and state what proportion of the expense is to be borne by the municipalities."
