An Act to amend The Land Titles Act.

(Assented to , 1932.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Land Titles Act Amendment Act, 1932."

2. The Land Titles Act, being chapter 133 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended by inserting therein, immediately after section 29, the following new section:

"29a. No instrument affecting any land situate within an irrigation district which affects less than the total amount of land comprised in the subsisting certificate of title to such land shall be registered unless and until it has been proved to the satisfaction of the Registrar that such instrument has been approved by the trustees of the irrigation district within which such land is situate, and unless and until such instrument is so approved, the same shall have no force or effect whatsoever."
