HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Reclamation Act Repeal Act."
- **2.** The Reclamation Act, being chapter 47 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby repealed.
- **3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
