# BILL

No. 21 of 1932.

An Act to repeal The Reclamation Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1932.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as “*The Reclamation Act Repeal Act.*”

**2.** *The Reclamation Act*, being chapter 47 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby repealed.

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
