A BILL TO AMEND THE NEW WEST I.D. COLONIZATION ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill provides that in respect of all advances made by the manager to an approved water user for the purpose of assisting him in his farming operations, the manager shall have a first charge upon all crops grown upon the land of the borrower in the year in which the advance is made and in every year thereafter, and empowers the manager to seize and sell the crop subject to the charge as he may deem proper.

An Act to amend The New West I.D. Colonization Act.

(Assented to , 1932.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The New West I.D. Colonization Act Amendment Act, 1932."

2. The New West I.D. Colonization Act, being chapter 72 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1931, is hereby amended as to section 17 thereof by adding thereto the following new subsection:

"(3) In addition to all other securities which the manager may have for recovering the repayment of any money hereafter expended for or lent to any approved water user for the purposes last before mentioned, or any of them, the manager shall, notwithstanding anything in any other Act to the contrary, have a first charge upon all crops which are grown upon the land of such approved water user in the year in which such money is so expended or lent and in every year thereafter, and the manager may enforce such charge by himself or his agent by distress, seizure and sale of the crop subject to the charge in any manner the manager may deem proper and none of the provisions of *The Extra-Judicial Seizures Act* shall apply to any such distress, seizure or sale."
