A BILL TO AMEND THE LOCAL TAX ARREARS
CONSOLIDATION ACT.

NOTE.

By this Bill the provisions of *The Local Tax Arrears Consolidation Act* are extended for the year 1932, and the provisions of the Act are made applicable to cities, towns and villages as well as to municipal districts, improvement districts and school districts.

An Act to amend The Local Tax Arrears Consolidation Act.

(Assented to _____, 1932.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Local Tax Arrears Consolidation Act Amendment Act, 1932.*"

2. *The Local Tax Arrears Consolidation Act*, being chapter 54 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1931, is hereby amended by striking out the figures "1931" where the same occur therein and by substituting therefor the figures "1932."

3. The said Act is further amended by striking out the figures "1932" where the same occur therein and by substituting therefor the figures "1933."

4. The said Act is further amended as to section 2 thereof by striking out clause (c) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

"(c) 'Municipality' means any city, town, village, municipal district and improvement district, and includes a school district which levies and collects school taxes."

5. The said Act is further amended as to section 3 thereof by striking out the words "used for farm purposes" where the same occur therein.

6. All rights and liabilities created or subsisting by virtue of any by-law or agreement made pursuant to *The Local Tax Arrears Consolidation Act* at any time before the coming into force of this Act shall continue as if this Act had not been passed.
