

Bill No. 39 of 1932.

A BILL TO AMEND THE TOWN ACT, 1927.

NOTE.

Section 2 of the Bill makes new provisions as to the liability of the town for the medical care and treatment of indigents upon the same being furnished without a written order, and defines the liability of the town in respect thereof.

Section 3 of the Bill provides that the Court of Revision shall not vary an assessment if such assessment bears a fair and just proportion to the values at which lands in the town are assessed.

Section 4 of the Bill confers upon a council the power to secure the repayment of temporary loans by a pledge of unpaid taxes.
