An Act to amend The Provincial Police Act, 1928.


HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Provincial Police Act, 1928, Amendment Act, 1932.*"

2. *The Provincial Police Act, 1928*, being chapter 47 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1928, is hereby amended as to section 2 thereof by striking out the words "a Superintendent" where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "the Commissioner or an Assistant Commissioner."

3. From and after the first day of April, 1932, those provisions of *The Alberta Police Act* relating to the establishment, continuance and maintenance of the Alberta Provincial Police Force shall cease to be in force unless and until the Lieutenant Governor in Council by proclamation declares that the same shall be again in force as and from a date to be named in such proclamation.

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
