A BILL TO AMEND THE SCHOOL GRANTS ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill makes provision for the payment of the ordinary school grants in the case of pupils of a school district to which *The Border Areas Act* applies who reside in that part of the joint district which is within the Province of Alberta and who receive education in grades above grade VIII in a school within the district but located in an adjoining Province.

An Act to amend The School Grants Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The School Grants Act Amendment Act, 1932."
- **2.** The School Grants Act, being chapter 53 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended by inserting therein, immediately after section 7 thereof, the following new section:
- "7a. In the case of any joint school district established under the provisions of The Border Areas Act, if pupils who are resident in that part of such joint district which is situate in Alberta are furnished with tuition in grades above the eighth as classified by the regulations of the Department in an educational institution in that part of the joint district which is situate in the adjoining Province which receives a grant in respect of such pupils from the Government of such Province, there shall be paid to the Government of such Province by way of a grant a sum which bears the same ratio to the total which would have been payable under this Act in respect of such educational institution if the same had been a school operated in Alberta under the provisions of The School Act, as the total daily average attendance of pupils resident in Alberta bears to the total daily average attendance of all pupils taught at such educational institution for the school term in respect of which the grant is paid."
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to, and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times from and after the first day of April, 1931.
