A BILL TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE RESPECTING
THE EXEMPTION FROM TAXATION OF
BEET SUGAR FACTORIES

This Bill extends the operation of an Ordinance respecting the exemption from taxation of Beet Sugar Factories, being chapter 24 of the Ordinances of the North-West Territories, 1901, until the first day of January, 1933.

An Act to amend an Ordinance respecting the exemption
from taxation of Beet Sugar Factories.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Beet Sugar Factories
Ordinance Amendment Act, 1932.*"

2. An Ordinance respecting the exemption from taxation
of Beet Sugar Factories, being chapter 24 of the Ordinances
of the North-West Territories, 1901, is hereby amended as
to section 1 thereof by striking out the words "until the
expiration of twenty years from the date on which this
Ordinance shall come into force," where the same occur
therein, and by substituting therefor the words "until the
first day of January, 1933."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which
it is assented to.
