An Act to authorize the Guarantee of Certain Borrowings
by Farmers for Binder Twine.

(Assented to _____, 1932.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. The Lieutenant Governor in Council is empowered to guarantee the repayment to each of the banks named in the first column of the Schedule to this Act of the aggregate sums lent, during the year 1931, for binder twine by each such bank, with the approval of the Director appointed under *The Debt Adjustment Act*, to farmers for the purpose of acquiring the binder twine necessary for harvesting a crop in 1931, whereof the amount outstanding and owing to the banks named in the first column of the schedule as at the thirty-first day of January, 1931, was the sum set out in the second column of the Schedule, opposite the name of the bank.
