HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent  
of the Legislative Assembly of the Province  
of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Private  
Streets Act."

2. In this Act, unless the context requires a  
contrary meaning, the expression,-

(a) "Private street" means any street, road,  
lane or track which is not vested in a  
public authority;

(b) "Public authority" means the Province and  
any city, town, village and municipal dist

3. There shall be a full and free right to eve  
member of the public at all times during the day  
time of travelling on foot over every private str  
which serves as the common means of access to or  
egress from ten or more separate dwellings for th  
of visiting or transacting business with
