An Act to amend The Judicature Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Judicature Act Amendment Act, 1932."
- **2.** The Judicature Act, being chapter 72 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended by adding thereto, immediately after clause (d) of section 35, the following new clause:
  - "(dd) In any action, cause or matter for the recovery of a debt or liquidated demand, or for the enforcement of any security or charge on land, or for determination or specific performance of any agreement for the sale of land, or for the possession of land, the Court may, in its absolute discretion, at any stage of such action, cause, or matter grant a stay of proceedings on such terms as the Court may prescribe, or without imposing any terms and in like manner the Court may, in its absolute discretion, with or without imposing terms, after final judgment in any action, cause or matter whatever, grant a stay of execution, order for sale or other similar process, including an order for possession of land, and may by any order granting such stay, extend the time for payment of any judgment debt or the time for doing any act or making any payment prescribed by any previous order of the Court; and for the purposes of this clause, the expression 'action, cause or matter' shall be deemed to include proceedings taken under section 95 of The Land Titles Act."
