An Act to amend The Legislative Assembly Act.

(Assented to _____, 1932.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Legislative Assembly Act Amendment Act, 1932.*"

2. *The Legislative Assembly Act*, being chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 10 thereof by inserting therein, immediately after subsection (2) thereof, the following new subsection:

"(2a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Act, a member of the Legislative Assembly shall not be ineligible as a member thereof nor shall his seat become vacated by reason of his accepting or holding any of the following offices, namely: President or Chairman of the Council, Attorney General, Provincial Secretary, Minister of Agriculture, Minister of Public Works, Minister of Education, Minister of Public Health, Minister of Municipal Affairs, Minister of Railways and Telephones, Minister of Lands and Mines, Provincial Treasurer, or the Minister or head of any other public department that may hereafter be organized by Statute of this Province."
