Section 2 of this Bill enlarges the powers of the Board as to the division of industries into classes and subclasses.

Section 3 of the Bill authorizes the Board to make a differential assessment as between classes of industry and subclasses of industry.

An Act to amend The Workmen's Compensation Act (Accident Fund).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Workmen's Compensation Act (Accident Fund) Amendment Act, 1933.'

2. The Workmen's Compensation Act (Accident Fund), being chapter 177 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 16 thereof by striking out subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the

- subsection (1),
 following:
 "16.—(1) The Board is empowered—
 "(a) to add to, withdraw from or rearrange any industries which are or may be included in the schedules
 - "(b) to divide any industry into one or more classes, and any class into one or more subclasses, having regard to the general conditions prevailing in that industry in any area or to any special condition as to operation or otherwise, and to include any such class or classes in such one or more of the classes of industry established pursuant to this Act, as the Board may deem proper."

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 20 thereof by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection:

"(12) Assessments may be made in such manner and form and by such procedure as the Board may deem adequate and expedient, and may be general as applicable to any class or subclass, or special as applicable to any in-dustry or part or department of any industry."

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
