An Act to amend The Companies Act, 1929.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Companies Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1933."
- 2. The Companies Act, 1929, being chapter 14 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended as to section 18 thereof by striking out the expression "subsection (2)" where the same occurs therein, and by substituting therefor the expression "subsection (3)."
- **3.** The said Act is further amended as to section 87 thereof by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection:
- subsection:

 "(10) For the purpose of this section an assignment of book debts to which The Assignment of Book Debts Act, 1929, applies and which is required to be registered pursuant to the provisions of that Act shall not be deemed to be a mortgage or a floating charge."
- **4.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times from and after the first day of October, 1929.
