HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Stock Inspection Act Amendment Act, 1933."

2. The Stock Inspection Act, being chapter 69 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended by inserting therein, immediately after section 22 thereof, the following new section:

22*a*.—(1) Every person who carries on the business of fox farming shall at all times keep at his place of business in a book kept for that purpose a record of all horses and cattle purchased by him, setting out therein the age, sex, brands (if any) and markings of every such animal and shall also, in the same manner, keep a record of all horses and cattle slaughtered by him or by his direction.

"(2) Every person who has the custody or possession of any such record shall produce the same at any time on demand for inspection to any policeman or stock inspector.

any such record shall produce the same at any time of demand for inspection to any policeman or stock inspector. "(3) The hide of any animal slaughtered by or by the direction of any person engaged in the business of fox farming shall be retained in the possession of such last mentioned person for a period of ten days and the person for the time being having the possession or custody thereof shall, within such period, produce the same on demand for examination to any policeman or stock inspector.

"(4) Every person engaged in the business of fox farming shall, not later than the tenth day of each month, forward to the Minister a return from the record kept by him pursuant to this section setting out all entries made in the record so kept during the preceding month."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
