## A BILL TO AMEND THE AUCTIONEERS AND PEDLERS ACT.

## NOTE.

This Bill provides for a special license for a hawker or pedler selling such goods manufactured in Alberta as are specified therein, and limits the fee chargeable for a municipal license in respect of the holder of such special license to the sum of five dollars.

An Act to amend The Auctioneers and Pedlers Act.

(Assented to

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Auctioneers and Pedlers Act Amendment Act, 1933."
- **2.** The Auctioneers and Pedlers Act, being chapter 39 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 6 thereof by adding thereto the following new subsections:
- "(2) A license may be issued authorizing any person to
- "(2) A license may be issued authorizing any person to sell as a hawker or pedler any articles manufactured in Alberta specified therein.

  "(3) Where a license has been issued to any person pursuant to this section, no city, town, village or municipal district shall charge such person a greater fee than five dollars for an annual license to hawk or peddle in the municipality the articles specified in the first mentioned license."
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
