An Act to amend The Change of Name Act.

(Assented to , 1933.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Change of Name Act Amendment Act, 1933."

2. The Change of Name Act, being chapter 230 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 4 thereof by striking out the words "upon payment of the fees prescribed in the schedule to this Act register the change of names," where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "upon payment of the fees prescribed in the schedule to this Act, or such lesser fees as may be from time to time prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council, register the change of names."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
