An Act to amend The Government Liquor Control Act of Alberta.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Government Liquor Control Act of Alberta Amendment Act, 1933."
- 2. The Government Liquor Control Act of Alberta, being chapter 14 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1924, is hereby amended as to section 33 thereof by striking out subsection (2) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:
- "(2) The number of beer licenses in cities, towns and villages shall not in any one year exceed: one license for the first five hundred population, or fraction thereof; a second license for the next five hundred population or fraction thereof up to one thousand population; a third license for a population of at least two thousand; a fourth license for a population of at least three thousand; a fifth license for a population of at least four thousand; and one license for each additional four thousand of population thereafter."
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
