# BILL

No. 11 of 1934.

An Act to amend The Domestic Animals (Unorganized Territory) Act.

(Assented to 1934.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Domestic Animals (Unorganized Territory) Act Amendment Act, 1934.*"

**2.** *The Domestic Animals (Unorganized Territory) Act*, being chapter 67 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 2 thereof by inserting therein, immediately after paragraph (m) thereof, the following new paragraph:

“(m) ‘Occupier’ means any person who, being the owner, purchaser under an agreement for sale, lessee or tenant of any land, is for the time being in the actual occupation of the land.”

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
