An Act to amend The Women's Institute Act, 1929.

(Assented to 1934.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Women's Institute Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1934.*"

2. *The Women's Institute Act, 1929*, being chapter 6 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended as to section 35 thereof by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection:

"(4) Any girl over the age of six years may be admitted as a member of a Women's Institute Girls' Club."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
