HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Women's Institute Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1934."
- 2. The Women's Institute Act, 1929, being chapter 6 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended as to section 35 thereof by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection:

"(4) Any girl over the age of six years may be admitted as a member of a Women's Institute Girls' Club."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
