An Act to amend The Provincial Police Act, 1928.

(Assented to 1934.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Provincial Police Act, 1928, Amendment Act, 1934.*"

2. *The Provincial Police Act, 1928*, being chapter 47 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1928, is hereby amended as to section 2 thereof by striking out the words "the Commissioner or an Assistant Commissioner of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police," where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "the officer in command for the time being of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police in the Province."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
