An Act to amend The Drainage Districts Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Drainage Districts Act Amendment Act, 1934."
- 2. The Drainage Districts Act, being chapter 46 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 155n thereof by striking out the words "other than the charge imposed by any debentures," where the same occur in subsection (2) and subsection (4) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "other than those arising from claims of the Crown in the right of the Dominion of Canada and the charge imposed by any debentures."
- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{3.}}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
