A BILL TO AMEND THE IRRIGATION
DISTRICTS ACT.

NOTE.

The amendment made by this Bill has the effect of excluding claims of the Crown in the right of the Province from the encumbrances which remain against the title to land vested in a Board of Trustees as a result of rate enforcement proceedings.

An Act to amend The Irrigation Districts Act.

(Assented to 1934.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Irrigation Districts Act Amendment Act, 1934.*"

2. *The Irrigation Districts Act*, being chapter 114 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 155 thereof by striking out the words "other than the charge imposed by any debentures," where the same occur in subsection (2) and subsection (4) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "other than those arising from claims of the Crown in the right of the Dominion of Canada and the charge imposed by any debentures."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
