An Act to amend The Official Guardian Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Official Guardian Act Amendment Act, 1934."
- 2. The Official Guardian Act, being chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 4 thereof by inserting therein, immediately after paragraph (d) thereof, the following new paragraph:

 "(da) either alone or jointly with any other person or persons, accept and carry out any trust provided that he is appointed for that purpose either in the instrument creating the trust, or if appointed after the creation of the trust, he is so appointed with the consent of the majority of the persons beneficially interested therein who are for the time being of full age and capable in law of giving a valid consent."
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
