 \mathbf{H}^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Municipal Hail Insurance Act Amendment Act, 1934."

2. The Municipal Hail Insurance Act, being chapter 174 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 36 thereof by striking out subsection (1a) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

"(1a) Notwithstanding the provisions of this or any other Act, no name other than the name of the person who made an application under the provisions of section 24 of this Act need be entered upon the assessment roll in respect of the hail insurance tax and no notice of assessment or taxation need be sent to any person other than the person who so made application."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force, shall be deemed to have been in force at all times from and after the eighth day of April, 1926.
