# BILL

No. 62 of 1934.

An Act to amend The Alimony Orders Enforcement Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1934.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Alimony Orders Enforcement Act Amendment Act, 1934.*"

**2.** *The Alimony Orders Enforcement Act*, being chapter 25 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1932, is hereby amended as to section 2 thereof by inserting therein, immediately after paragraph (c) thereof, the following:

"(d) 'Alimony,' in addition to its ordinary meaning, includes any sum which is made payable to a wife for her maintenance and support by any order made where a judgment of divorce or nullity of marriage has been obtained."

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
