HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Exemptions Act Amendment Act, 1934."

2. The Exemptions Act, being chapter 95 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 6 thereof by striking out the word "alimony", where the same occurs therein, and by substituting therefor the words "alimony or for the payment of maintenance by a hushand to his wife or to his former wife, as the case may be".

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
