No. 82 of 1934.

An Act to further amend The Municipal District Act.

(Assented to 1934).

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts  
as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Municipal District Act  
Amendment Act, 1934, No. 2."

2. The Municipal District Act, being chapter 41 of the  
Statutes of Alberta, 1926, is hereby amended as to section  
160 thereof by adding at the end thereof the following new  
subsections.

"(2) A council may by by-law make provision for the supplying  
of medical care and attention to the residents of the municipal  
district by means of a contract or agreement, either alone or  
in conjunction with the council of any other municipal district  
or municipal districts, either by way of guarantee or upon any  
other basis:

"Provided that no contract or agreement made pursuant to this  
section shall have any force or effect until it has been approved  
in writing by the Minister of Health.

"(3) A council desiring to pass a by-law under this section  
shall proceed as is set out in subsections (2) to (5) inclusive  
of section 157 of this Act.

"(4) Upon being approved in writing by the Minister of Health,  
any contract or agreement of the kind mentioned in this section  
which has been entered into between a council and any duly regis-  
tered medical practitioner at any time before the first day of  
April, 1934, shall be good, valid and effectual for all purposes,  
and any and all payments hereto ore made by any municipal district  
in respect of or by virtue of any contract or agreement so approv-  
ed are hereby validated, ratified and confirmed."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is  
assented to.
