An Act to authorize David Gordon Alexander Campbell to practise osteopathy.

WHEREAS David Gordon Alexander Campbell, of the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, Doctor of Osteopathy, has presented a petition praying for an enactment entitling the said petitioner to be registered as an osteopath by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Alberta without being required to pass any test examination; and

Whereas it appears by the said petition that the said David Gordon Alexander Campbell is a fully qualified and experienced Doctor of Osteopathy; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. It shall and may be lawful for the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Alberta, notwithstanding anything contained in The Medical Profession Act of the Province of Alberta, to enter the name of David Gordon Alexander Campbell in the "Alberta Medical Register" as an osteopath and the said college shall, upon the said David Gordon Alexander Campbell presenting to the said college satisfactory proof and evidence that he graduated from a recognized College of Osteopathy, and upon his paying the proper registration fees but without the necessity of his passing any test examination, so enter the name of the said David Gordon Alexander Campbell in the "Alberta Medical Register."

2. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
