**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Public Service Act Amendment Act, 1935."
- 2. The Public Service Act, being chapter 7 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 3 thereof by striking out paragraphs (k) and (l) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

  "(k) The Department of Lands and Mines;

  "(l) The Department of Trade and Industry;

  "(m) The Office of the King's Printer;

  "(n) The Office of the Legislative Assembly."
- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{3.}}$  This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
