A BILL TO AMEND THE BOILERS ACT, 1929.

NOTE.

This Bill provides that no person shall use any second-hand pressure vessel acquired by him unless he has obtained the permission of the inspector so to do (section 3), and strikes out that part of section 30 as being unnecessary (section 2).

An Act to amend The Boilers Act, 1929.

(Assented to _____, 1935.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Boilers Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1935.*"

2. *The Boilers Act, 1929*, being chapter 31 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended as to section 30 thereof by striking out the words "This provision shall not affect the right of an owner to transfer to a manufacturer or dealer any second-hand pressure vessel.", where the same occur therein.

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 31 thereof by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:

"**31.** No person shall use any second-hand pressure vessel acquired by him until he has obtained permission from an inspector to use the same."

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
