A BILL TO AMEND THE DOMESTIC ANIMALS ACT (MUNICIPALITIES).

NOTE.

Section 2 of this Bill makes the contravention of a by-law prohibiting the running at large of domestic animals, passed pursuant to section 16, an offence, and provides a penalty therefor.

Section 3 provides that the persons qualified to vote on such a by-law are the persons entitled to vote on debenture by-laws in a town, village or municipal district, as the case may be.

An Act to amend The Domestic Animals Act (Municipalities)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Domestic Animals Act (Municipalities) Amendment Act, 1935."
- 2. The Domestic Animals Act (Municipalities), being chapter 25 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1923, is hereby amended as to section 16 thereof by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection:
- of the following new subsection:

 "(5) Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of any by-law passed pursuant to this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction therefor to a penalty of not more than one hundred dollars for each day during which the contravention continues, together with costs, and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term of not more than three months."
- 3. The said Act is further amended as to section 17 thereof—
 - (a) by striking out the words "resident electors," where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "proprietary electors"; and
 - (b) by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection:
 - "(7) For the purposes of this section the expression 'proprietary electors' means those persons who are entitled to vote upon debenture by-laws in a town, village or municipal district, as the case may be."
- $\boldsymbol{4.}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
