 \mathbf{H}^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Relief Liability Act Amendment Act, 1935."

2. The Relief Liability Act, being chapter 64 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1934, is hereby amended as to section 4 thereof by striking out the words "or entitled to relief during any time", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "or entitled to relief resided during any time".
