An Act to amend The Estates of the Mentally Incompetent $\ensuremath{\operatorname{Act.}}$

(Assented to , 1935.)

 \mathbf{H}^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Estates of the Mentally Incompetent Act Amendment Act, 1935."

2. The Estates of the Mentally Incompetent Act, being chapter 225 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 4 thereof by striking out the words "the guardian of any mentally incompetent person", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "the guardian of the estate of any mentally incompetent person".

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to, and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times since the tenth day of April, 1925. No. 61.
