# A BILL TO AMEND THE SOLEMNIZATION OF $\label{eq:marriage} \text{MARRIAGE ACT}.$

NOTE.

The amendment made by this Act requires each party to an intended marriage to make an affidavit that he or she is not infected with any venereal or communicable disease.

In the case of marriage by banns the affidavit must be delivered to the officiating clergyman before the marriage is solemnized. In other cases the affidavit must be delivered to the marriage license issuer before the issuance of the license.

### BILL

An Act to amend The Solemnization of Marriage Act.

(Assented to , 1935.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Solemnization of Marriage Act, 1935."
- 2. The Solemnization of Marriage Act, being chapter 39 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1925, is hereby amended as to section 4 thereof by striking out paragraph (b) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

  "(b) a certificate of the due publication of banns and in
  - "(b) a certificate of the due publication of banns and in addition an affidavit by each party to the intended marriage setting out that the party making the affidavit is not then infected with any venereal disease or any other communicable disease, which affidavit shall be in Form E of the schedule to this Act;".
- **3.** The said Act is further amended as to section 13 thereof by striking out subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:
  - "(1) No issuer shall issue a marriage license until-
  - "(a) both of the parties to the intended marriage have made and delivered to him an affidavit in Form B in the schedule hereto; and
  - "(b) each of the parties to the intended marriage has delivered to him either an affidavit setting out that the party making the affidavit is not then infected with any venereal disease or any other communicable disease, which affidavit shall be in Form E in the schedule to this Act."
- ${\bf 4.}$  The said Act is further amended as to the schedule thereof by adding thereto the following new form:
