HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The School Grants Act Amendment Act, 1935."
- 2. The School Grants Act, being chapter 53 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 25 thereof by striking out the words "the Department", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "the Department or on account of the illness of the teacher for a period not in excess of the period of illness for which the district is liable for the payment of salary to the teacher".
- ${\bf 3.}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
