- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Execution Creditors Act Amendment Act, 1935."
- 2. The Execution Creditors Act, being chapter 8 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1934, is hereby amended as to section 29 thereof by striking out the words "six months", where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "twelve months".
