## A BILL WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN INDEBTED-NESS FOR POISONED GRASSHOPPER BAIT.

This Bill relieves municipalities and persons indebted to the Government for grasshopper bait supplied under *The Agricultural Pests Act* from that indebtedness which is assumed by the Province as an expenditure in the interests of agriculture.

# BILL

### No. 80 of 1935.

#### An Act with respect to certain Indebtedness for Poisoned Grasshopper Bait.

### (Assented to , 1935.)

 $\mathbf{H}^{\mathrm{IS}}$  MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "The Grasshopper Bait Indebtedness Act."

2. Every person and every municipality now indebted to the Province in respect of any poisoned bait for the purpose of destroying grasshoppers furnished at any time heretofore pursuant to any of the provisions of *The Agricultural Pests Act*, being chapter 71 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is each hereby released and discharged from all claims, demands and liability in respect of such indebtedness; and all costs incurred by the Province in furnishing any such person or municipality with any poisoned bait as aforesaid shall be assumed and borne by the Province and shall be deemed to be an expenditure for the good and welfare of agriculture.

 $\ensuremath{\mathbf{3.}}$  This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
