An Act to amend The Chiropractic Act, 1923.

(Assented to _____, 1935.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Chiropractic Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1935.*"

2. *The Chiropractic Act*, being chapter 58 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1923, is hereby amended as to section 4 thereof:

(a) By striking out subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

"(1) There shall be constituted an advisory Board of Examiners consisting of five members to be appointed by the Minister, all of whom shall be persons resident in the Province and graduates of a School of Chiropractics which requires for its course of instruction not less than eighteen months' resident study within a period not exceeding three years."

(b) By adding at the end of subsection (4) thereof the following new subsection:

"(4a) The Board shall at its first meeting elect one of its members to be the chairman of the Board for its ensuing term of office."

3. The said Act is further amended as to Section 7, subsection (2) thereof by striking out paragraphs (a) and (b) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

"(a) As to the educational qualifications of the applicant;

"(b) That he is the holder of a diploma issued to him by a School of Chiropractics recognized by the Board; provided that no School of Chiropractic shall be recognized which does not require as a condition precedent to the granting of a diploma a course of instruction of not less than eighteen (18) months resident study within a period not exceeding three years."

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
