An Act for the Conservation of Straw for Fodder Purposes.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Straw Conservation Act."
- 2.-(1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may by order from time to time declare any specified part of the Province to be a straw conservation area as and from a date specified in the order, and every area so declared shall continue until it is further ordered that from and after a specified date the area shall cease to exist.
- (2) Every such order shall be published in The Alberta Gazette.
- 3. No person shall, in a straw conservation area, destroy or cause or permit or allow to be destroyed any stack or pile of threshed straw until the expiration of the fourth year after the year in which the straw was threshed unless he is authorized so to do by the Field Crops Commissioner.
- 4. Every person who contravenes section 3 of this Act shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction therefor to a fine of not less than twenty dollars nor more than fifty dollars together with costs and in default of payment, to imprisonment for a term of not more than sixty days.
- 5. No prosecution under this Act shall be commenced by any person without the consent of the Minister of Agriculture.
- 6. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
